Filing 941 Electronically

Not all of our clients are on electronic filing for quarterly reports and year end reports. In an attempt to automate as many systems as possible, we are attempting to move everyone to electronic filings. If you are not automated yet, we have signed you up for this process. You will be receiving a PIN number in the mail from the IRS. It is highly important that you watch for this in the mail and get us the letter you receive from the IRS. Filing Electronically assures with confirmations that your data has been filed timely with the IRS with documented proof.

2016 Extended Tax Deadlines

If you haven't filed your taxes yet please keep in mind those deadlines may seem far away but time will fly by! The extended deadline for corporate returns is September 15th, 2017 and the extended deadline to file LLC and personal returns is October 15th, 2017.

Minimum Wage

Oregon is increasing their hourly minimum wage by \$1.50 to \$11.25 effective July 1st, 2017 for the Portland Metro Area. The standard urban counties are increasing 50 cents to \$10.25. And the Nonurban Counties are increasing 50 cents to \$10.00 per hour. There are three tiers of these rates based on your physical address. Please be aware of these changes and make adjustments on your end if necessary. The minimum wage is set to

increase again as of July 1st, 2018 as well. The goal for these changes is to get the minimum wage to \$14.75 inside Portland's urban growth boundary, \$13.50 in midsize counties, and \$12.50 in rural areas by 2022.
